Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #32 **Emergency Orders 49, 50, 51**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak, Egegik and Ugashik districts. The time is 12:00 noon and the date is Friday, July 10.

Naknek-Kvichak District

Escapement on the Naknek River from midnight to 10:00 a.m. today was 12,000 and total escapement is 744,000. The Alagnak River total escapement is 888,000, the Kvichak River total escapement is 2.5 million, and the Kvichak inriver estimate is 170,000. Harvest on July 9 was 210,000 fish for a total of 3.0 million. There are 393 vessels registered to fish in the district and there will be 459 in 48 hours.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for an 8.5-hour period from 9:30 p.m. Friday, July 10 until 6:00 a.m. Saturday, July 11. The Kvichak Section will open to drift gillnet gear for a 6-hour period from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, July 11. The current set gillnet fishing period in the Naknek-Kvichak District will be extended for 24.5 hours from 2:30 p.m. Friday, July 10 until 3:00 p.m. Saturday, July 11.

Egegik District

Egegik River total escapement is 1.6 million and the inriver estimate is 50,000 fish. The harvest on July 9 was 342,000 fish for a season total of 7.1 million.

The Egegik District will open to commercial fishing with drift gillnet gear for 7 hours from 7:30 p.m. Friday, July 10 to 2:30 a.m. Saturday, July 11 and again for 7 hours from 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Saturday, July 11. Commercial fishing with set gillnet gear will open for 8 hours from 7:45 p.m. Friday, July 10 to 3:45 a.m. Saturday, July 11 and again for 8 hours from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Saturday, July 11.

Ugashik District

Ugashik River total escapement is 1.1 million and the inriver estimate is 400,000 fish. The harvest on July 9 was 267,000 fish for a season total of 4.3 million.

The Ugashik District will open to drift and set gillnet gear for 16 hours from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Saturday, July 11.

Permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak, Egegik, and Ugashik districts should stand by at noon Saturday, July 11 for the next possible announcement.
