KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT # 18 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-18-26

There will be a **48-hour extension** to the current commercial salmon fishing period from **9:00 p.m. Friday, July 10** to **9:00 p.m. Sunday, July 12** in the **Inner and Outer Upper Station Sections** of the **Alitak District**. Waters remain open to the stream terminus of Olga Creek (stream #257-304).

As Previously Announced:

The **Cape Alitak, Humpy-Deadman, Alitak Bay, Moser Bay, and Olga Bay Sections** of the **Alitak District** **will close** to commercial salmon fishing at **9:00 p.m. Friday, July 10**.

The **Outer Ayakulik Section** of the **Southwest Kodiak District** is scheduled to **close** to commercial salmon fishing at **9:00 p.m. Sunday, July 12**.

The **Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area** (Telrod Cove) **remains open** to commercial salmon fishing until **further notice**.

Fishermen are reminded that in the **Kodiak Area (including the Mainland District)** until further notice, **Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length** may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350). Statistical Charts, Harvest Strategies, and Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations are available at the Kodiak Fish and Game office.
